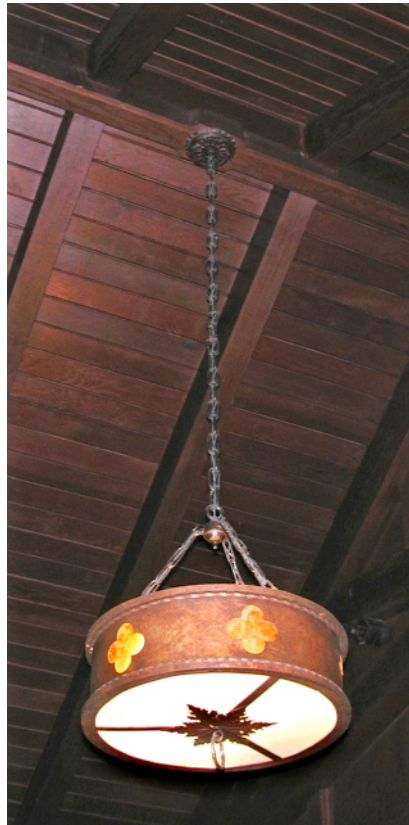


The JULIA

The Julia light is named for its designer, Julia Morgan, the first woman to receive an architecture degree in California. Locally, she is known for her many elegant and well crafted homes, churches, and public buildings. This light was made for the Sausalito Women's Club, and was reproduced from the original design. Julia's minimum length is 24"; there is no maximum. She is 20" wide and the main body is 6" high. Amber mica lines the quatrefoils around the side, and the bottom is normally caramel/white mottled glass, but other glass could be specified.
